

ICBF thanked for Veterans Court grant

The Friends of the Matt Brundage Memorial Ingham County Veterans Treatment Court (IVCTC) praised the Ingham County Bar Foundation for a \$2,600 grant on December 12th, 2012.

"This grant allows the Matt Brundage Memorial Veterans Treatment Court to continue to meet the needs of the community's veterans who find themselves in the criminal justice system" said Larry Salstrom, president of the Board for the Friends of the Matt Brundage Memorial IVCTC.

The ICVTC helps veterans help themselves by providing support through mentors and other services to veterans who find themselves in the criminal justice system.

Salstrom added, "This court was launched by Judge David L. Jordon with a goal to leave no veteran behind. As Judge Jordon retires, this grant means that the ICVTC will be able to keep reaching for that goal."
